School residentials and trips are subsidised for pupils eligible for Pupil Premium.

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2015/16

Supporting pupils in English and maths.

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The school will evaluate the impact of intervention on pupils at the end of every term. Evaluation will focus on academic gains and also how pupils' self-confidence has developed as a consequence of the intervention.

During the year two of these children left the school.

The remaining children made at least expected progress in both English and Maths.

One of the children made good progress in both English and Maths.
