Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2016/17

1. TA support to hear pupil read regularly and discuss reading habits. To focus on comprehension of reading.
2. TA support to facilitate planned opportunities for children to improve their communication skills through play and more structured PSHE lessons.
3. TA for support in PSHE focussing on 'getting along with others, keeping yourself safe and always trying your best.'

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

The school evaluates the impact of intervention on pupils at the end of every term during Pupil Progress meetings. Any lack of planned progress is then addressed through additional/ amended support.

Evaluation focuses on academic gains and also how pupils' self-confidence has developed as a consequence of the intervention.
