Kilve Court Residential

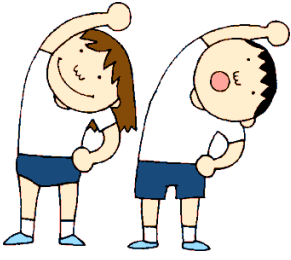
