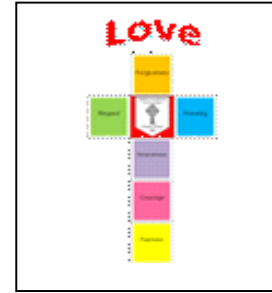

## Severe Weather



The weather forecast is for a cold snap with possible snow in some areas. In the event of snow the procedures are as follows:

Headteacher support and the Chair of Governors assess the situation first thing in the morning and make a joint decision whether or not to close the school.

If the decision is to close the school Mrs Vaughan will notify the Local Authority and they will update their website and notify the local radio stations, ie BBC Somerset Sound, Heart Radio, and they will announce the school closures. Mrs Vaughan will also contact our website administrator and the school website will be updated with a newsflash.

If there is a significant snowfall during the school day the situation will be monitored and staff will make a decision whether or not to keep the school open or to send children home early. We will make every effort to contact parents if the need arises but, if you are in any doubt or worried about road conditions, please telephone the school for an update.
